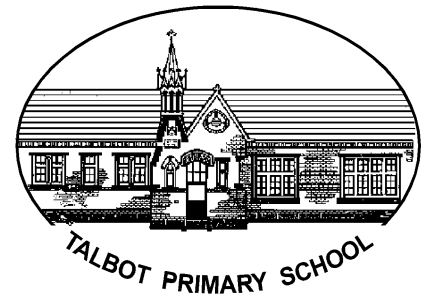

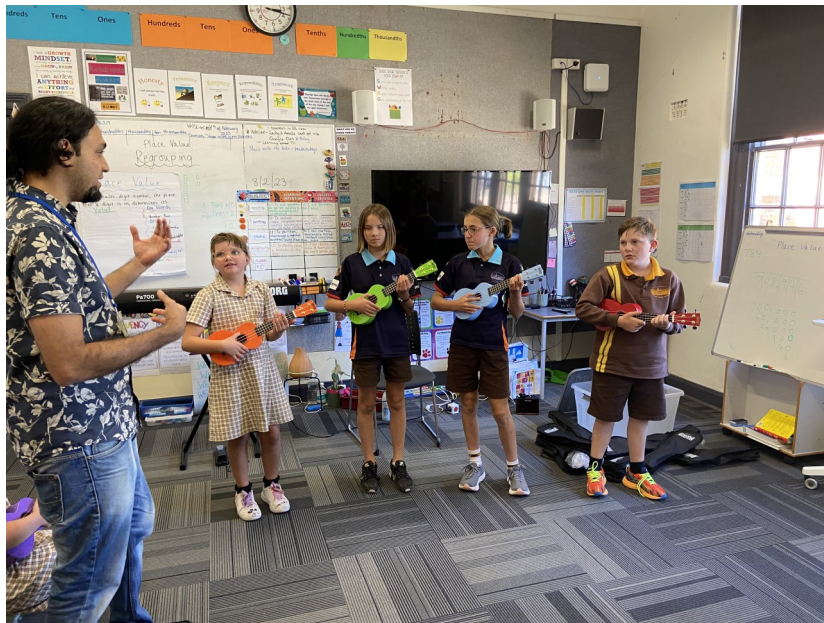
The AGM and first meeting of the 2023 Council will be held on Thursday 16th March @ 3:30pm during which the office bearers will be elected.
