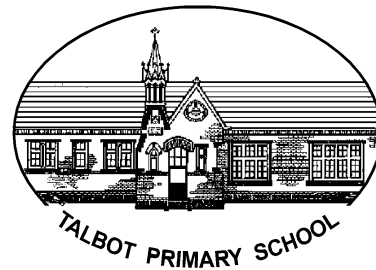

## Welcome back to Term 4!

Firstly, a huge thank you to our staff, students and families that supported the school working bee on Friday afternoon. Our garden beds, school boundaries and maintenance shed are all looking fresh and tidy again. Many hands make light work!

Term 4 is a busy, active term with Learning Conferences, Student Support Group meetings, 3/4 Camp to Creswick, Energy Breakthrough, Foundation transition, Swimming, Presentation Night (including Graduation) and end of year activities. It's very important to stay connected to Sentral to read notices and to read the newsletter.

## Bushfire Preparation

As we move into the warmer months, it is timely to remind families that Talbot Primary is listed on the Bushfire-at-risk-register (BARR). We are classified as Category 3 on the BARR which means that if the Fire Danger Rating reaches catastrophic in the North Central area then the school will be closed. In the event of a required closure, we would use Sentral to notify families. If the Fire Danger Rating changed to catastrophic with little notice, we would also contact families via phone or text. All staff and students took part in a 'Shelter-in-Place' drill last week and we were very proud of everyone's behaviour and the calmness they displayed.

A few reminders for families:

- \* Students are required to wear **hats** when outside in Term 4. School uniform hats can be purchased from the office for \$12.
- \* We have a general use **sunscreen** available in the Learning Street. Please encourage your child/ren to access and apply this as needed.
- \* As the weather warms up, we would appreciate all students bringing a **water bottle** everyday. These are placed on their desks so that they are easily accessible and this prevents students having to leave the room during learning sessions.
- \* Yard supervision at school begins from **8:45am** in the morning. Unless your child is attending Breakfast Club (M, W and F from 8:30am) or is arriving on the first bus run, they should not be dropped off earlier than 8:45am.

## Foundation Transition

We have several school visits organized for the Talbot Kindergarten 3- and 4-yr old group over the next few weeks before official Foundation Transition starts.

During these visits, the Kinder kids and our current Foundation students will sing some songs or complete a craft activity and then have playtime together.

Our 2025 Foundation Transition officially starts on Tuesday 19 November. More information will go out to all families with a prep starting next year, however please place the following dates in your diaries:

2 November - All Soul's Day (Christian day to remember and pray for the souls of the departed)

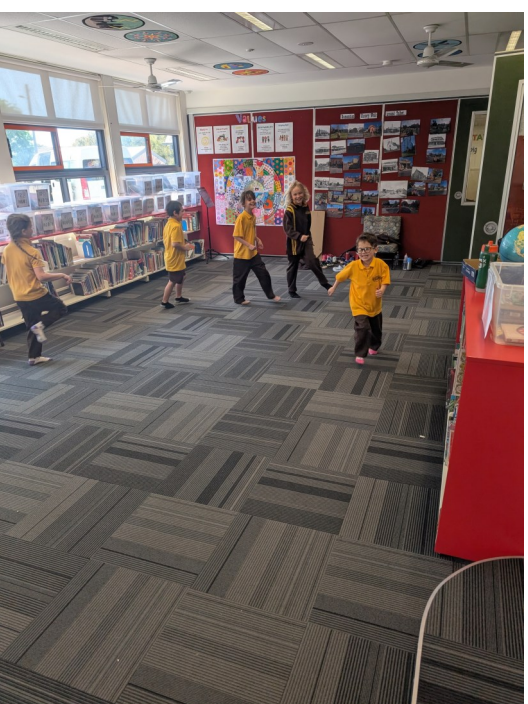
2 November - Bestu Varas (Gujarati New Year)
