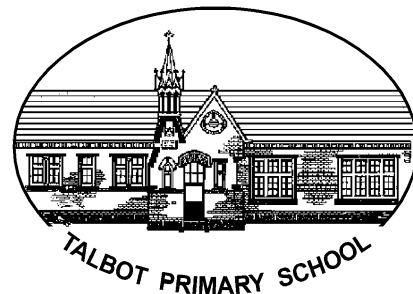

Grant Submissions

Today, Talbot Primary submitted two grant applications to receive funding from the Department of Education through the Victorian Schools Building Association (VSBA). There are never any guarantees that submissions will be successful, however it is important to apply when opportunities arise. An application can take significant time and effort to compile, and I would like to thank Fallon Cook, our school council president, and Joey for their help in locating required documentation and reading and researching various topics to ensure our application was as strong as possible.

The first grant application was for Minor Capital Works funding that will support the installation of secure and modern fencing on all boundaries. The second was an application for Inclusive Schools funding which would support the development of a structure to cover the basketball/tennis court, providing an undercover option for learning and play all year round.

Offers of funding will be announced towards the end of the school year.
