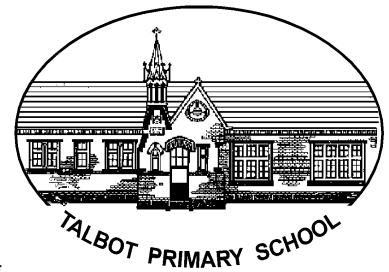

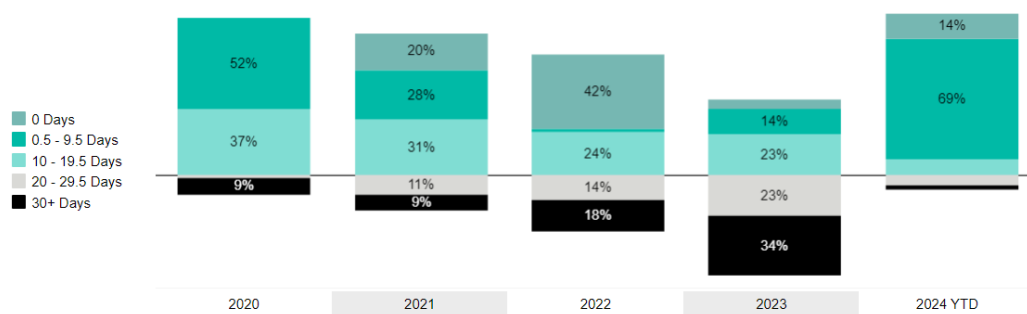
A reminder that the Year 1-3 Class Learning Conferences will be held tomorrow, Tuesday 7th May at 3:45pm.
