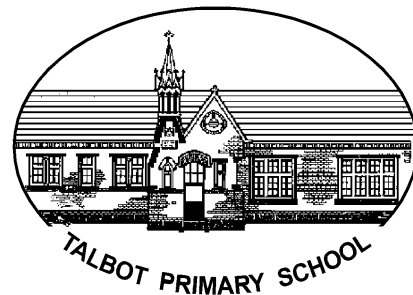

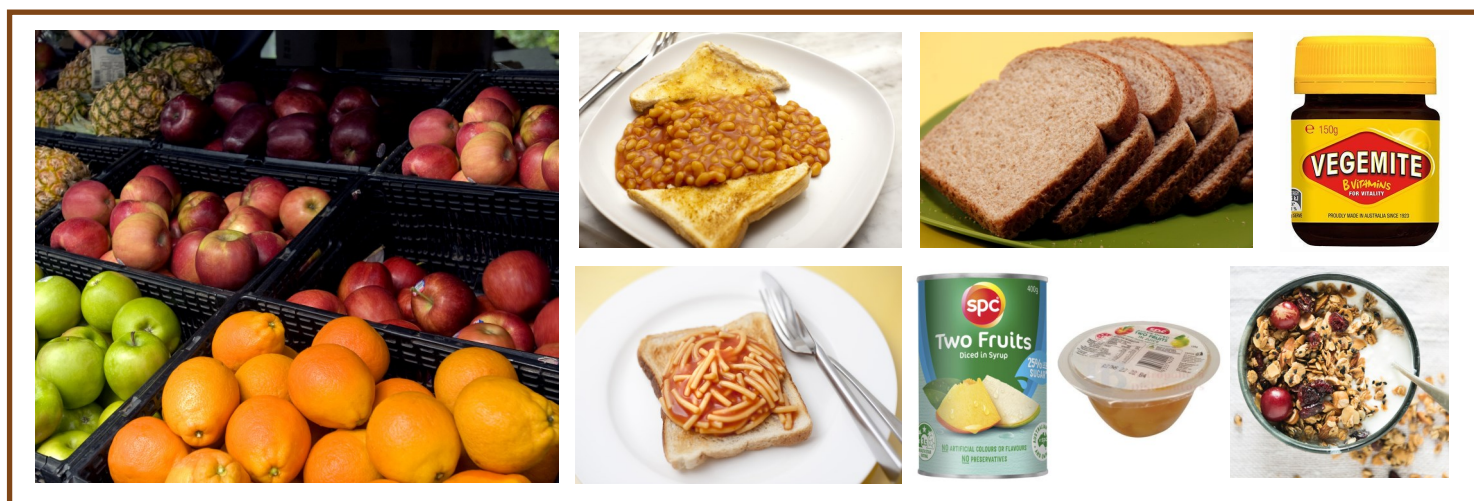


OUR PANTRY TO YOUR PANTRY

Please see Kylie in the office if you have any questions.



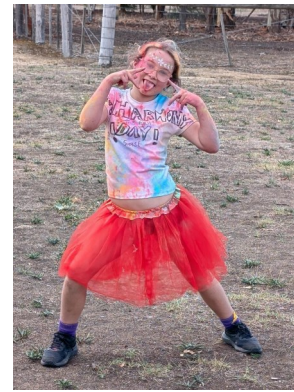
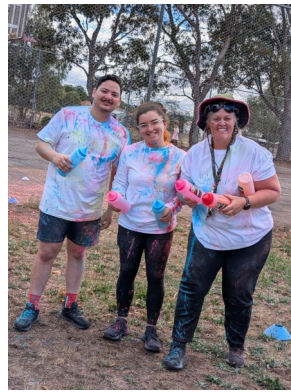
Talbot Primary School Vision
